Why should I rehome my pet myself?

Shelters are stressful places for pets and most shelters have too many pets and not enough adopters to help them. To make sure you find a safe and suitable home for your pet, the best thing you can do is keep them and look for a home yourself!

Getting your pet ready for rehoming:

- Make sure your pet is spayed or neutered and fully vaccinated - email PMA@onetail.org for help
- Make sure dogs have a well fitted collar and a leash
- Make a list for the new owner of everything important about your pet

Places to list your pet for adoption:

- Share with friends and family
- Utilize neighborhood groups on Facebook or NextDoor

Make sure it's a match

- Ask questions to make sure your pet is a match for the adopter
- Ask for contact information and an address
- Ask for references
- Be honest about your pet's needs and history
